

## **GP2GP – PCT Overview**

Dear Colleague

The GP2GP project is being delivered by NHS Connecting for Health together with PCTs and SHAs.

GP2GP allows patient electronic health records to be transferred directly between practices using the same type of clinical systems and also between different GP2GP compliant clinical systems, e.g. EMIS LV, EMIS Web and INPS Vision.

Many practices are already experiencing the benefits of using GP2GP, which include:

- Medical records are available to GPs at their first consultation with a patient.
- Retention of the richness of clinical data in the patient record.
- Fewer errors and omissions are incurred through the manual re-keying of data.
- Clinical and administrative time savings for practices.

PCTs are responsible for placing orders for GP2GP via the Tracking Database. Following the submission, the GP2GP project team at NHS Connecting for Health will contact you to agree which of your practices are eligible to go into the national roll out plan and agree on the deployment approach.
