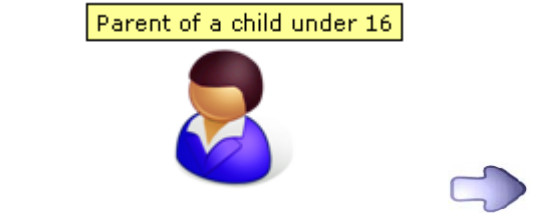


## SCR Business Process: 5a – Parent(s) managing their child’s Summary Care Record

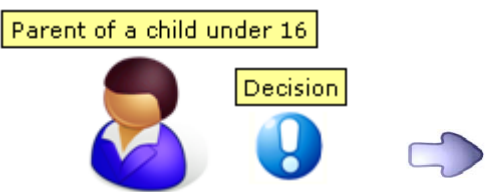
**Purpose:** The Parent wishes to decide if their child should have a Summary Care Record. The Health Care professional must assist in determining what is best for the patient.



Parent wishes to discuss the Summary Care Record implications for their child. They contact their GP Practice



The parent can speak to a GP, Health Care Professional or suitably trained member of the Practice staff. They will be able to explain all aspects of the SCR and how it will be used in support of any treatment their child may require.



Parent makes a decision about how they want their child’s record to be used – this may include their preference for the child not to have a Summary Care Record



A clinician will consider the Parents request and the interests of the Child.

**Question**

**?** *Is the child Gillick competent?*

**Yes** The clinician will inform the parent that the child is entitled to make the decision and can arrange for the child to attend the practice to discuss their wishes – refer to protocol 6a

**No** **Question**

**?** *Does the Parent want their child to have a Summary Care Record?*

**Yes** The clinician will record this decision on the practice system

**No** The clinician will consider if this is in the child’s best interests?

**!** **Decision** The clinician will consider the parents view and the interests of the child and consider other information sources available to them. They may also discuss the options further with the parent. Once they have made a decision, they will record the decision on their practice system.
